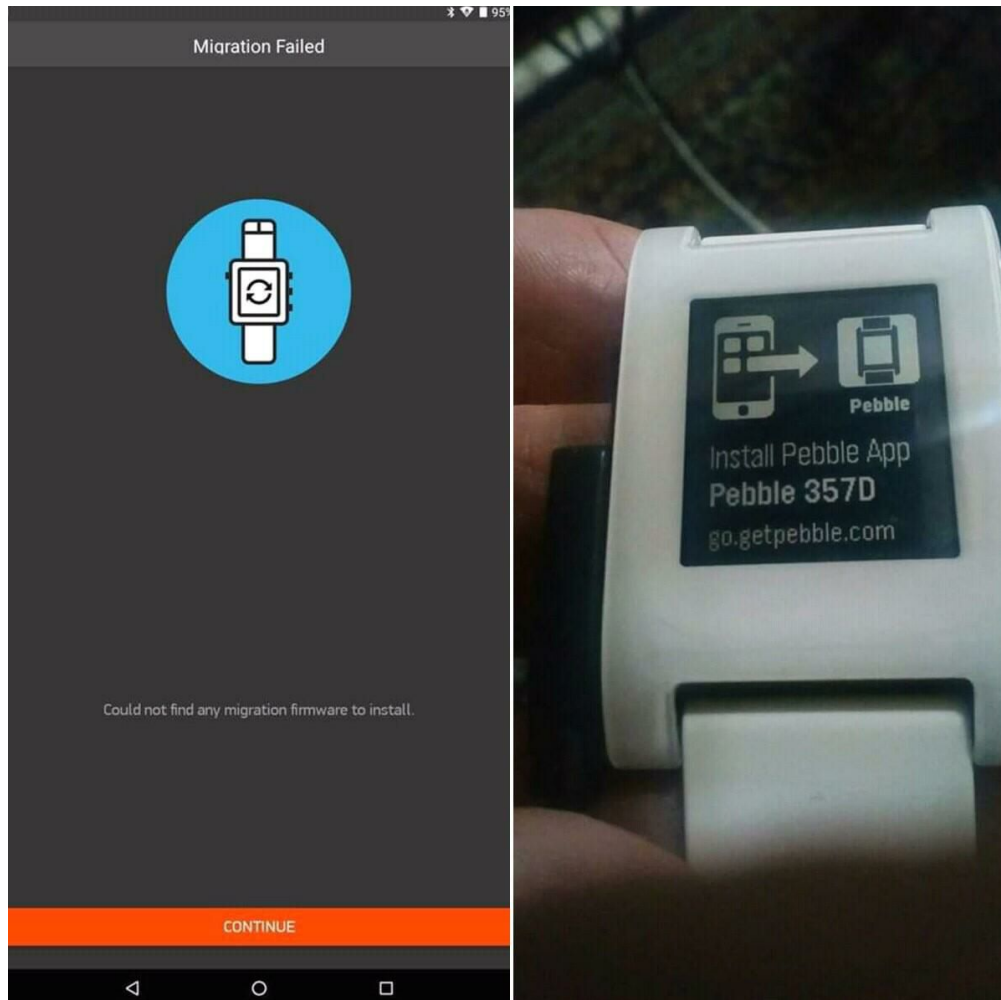


## How to fix "Migration Failed" error when using Rebble



### The Problem:

You try to connect to [Rebble](#) and you get the error message "Migration Failed. Could not find any migration firmware to install". Your Pebble has 3 firmwares installed: The normal operating firmware, recovery, and migration firmware. The migration firmware allows you to update to later OS versions on your Pebble. Your Pebble is either missing the migration firmware or it has become corrupt. Rebble will not automatically install this migration firmware. It must be present on your Pebble though to use Rebble services. **DO NOT ATTEMPT A FACTORY RESET OR YOU MAY BRICK YOUR PEBBLE** until you do the following.

### The Solution:

In order for Rebble to work with your Pebble you must have migration firmware installed. There are 2 ways to handle this. You can manually install the firmware by following the instructions [here](#).

Or, you can do it the easy way by using the [RPWS](#) Pebble Service. RPWS is similar to Rebble and will upgrade your Pebble firmware to 3.xx or greater automatically. Once upgraded, you can move freely between Rebble and RPWS. The services are similar but different. At the time of this writing RPWS does not support dictation. If you want to keep Rebble, simply sign in to RPWS, upgrade to version 3.xx, then switch back to Rebble! That's all there is to it!
